

Year 7 Catch Up Funding Premium 17/18

The literacy and numeracy catch-up premium provides schools with additional funds for each year 7 pupil who did not achieve at least level 4 in reading and/or maths at the end of key stage 2.

It is provided to all state-funded schools with a year 7 cohort, including special schools, alternative provision (AP) settings and pupil referral units (PRUs).

Payments will be made to local authorities for maintained schools.

In 2017/18 Paternoster received £1500 in funding for three Year 7 pupils. This was spent on:

- Thrass resources for developing phonics and handwriting
- Sensory resources to enhance learning
- Maths resources

The impact of this funding enabled three year seven pupils to make the following progress. There will continue to be no disparity between Year 7 and other year groups. Year 7 attainment will continue to be in line with whole school attainment.

- 23% made small steps of progress in reading
- 15% made small steps of progress in writing
- 25% made small steps of progress in maths
