

Analysis of KS2 and KS4 Pupil Assessment June18

As our pupils are not able to access formal end of Key Stage 2 tests we have no data for this. 12 pupils completed KS2 in September 2018 although not all were pupils at Paternoster for the full 4 years. In order to ascertain pupil progress in all departments across Paternoster data is collated and analysed at the end of a key stage. The school judges that 2 levels of progress across KS2 is expected progress and 3 levels+ is good/outstanding progress.

The data below is from a cohort of 12 pupils (3 pupils have no start data so effective cohort is 9).

English:

0% of the cohort maintained their level, 22% increased by 1 level, 44% increased by 2 levels and 33% increased by 3 or more levels.

Maths

11% of the cohort maintained their level, 22% increased by 1 level, 55% increased by 2 levels and 11% increased by 3 or more levels.

Analysis

- **English:** one third of the cohort have made outstanding progress. Cohort will be monitored next academic year.
- **Maths:** Cohort will be monitored next academic year.

Analysis of KS4 Pupil Assessment June18

The data below is from a cohort of 3 pupils (1 pupil has no start data so effective cohort is 2). *Cohort is very small and progress data should be analysed individually for these pupils.*

English:

Maths

Analysis

Both the above pupils have significant health issues; given this, we judge their progress to be good progress over KS4.

Analysis: 89% of pupils have achieved Median and Upper Quartile results in maths and English. Maths results are outstanding. English results are good as LQ is only 11%.

Cohorts are very small at KS3 and 4 and as a result, pupils' progress data is analysed individually.

These results have been compared against NPG. This is the last year that results will be compared against NPG as P Scales will no longer be used for national assessment. A new assessment framework will be introduced in September 2018.
